



Timeline of Activities




Committee Established

ACTION: Forged strong working relationship with NCDIT (Keith Conover); identified new grant funding, learned of technology updates & provider capabilities, obtained successful grant application examples



Advancing Partnerships

- Monthly broadband meetings (including NCDIT)
- Identified new grant opportunities for area providers to apply
- Partnered with providers via committee support letter for submitted applications
- Led successful ARC application by Skywave with Swain Chamber as county applicant
- Supported NTIA application, helped secure valuable pole data for provider application





RDOF Requirements:

Complete 40% of proposed deployments in first 3 years, 20% more in 4 years. Minimal penalties to walk away. No on-site work has started, no subsequent grants can cover RDOF areas.

CAB - Completing Access to Broadband

\$4M max per county with required matching: \$400k Provider & \$200k County

- Total award corresponds with match amounts
- County + NC-DIT develop RFP
- RDOF exclusions apply
- County forwards its match to DIT; DIT oversees application, award, implementation
- Unfunded GREAT applications are eligible
- CAB guidance posted on 6/24/2022*
- Reliable service is now a factor. Fixed Wireless only on licensed frequencies.
- Information Session to be announced.
- No movement on CAB until all GREAT Grants are finalized and awarded.

Middle Mile Broadband Infrastructure

Funding to enable providers to build better backhaul middle mile capability

- \$980M total each grant \$5M \$100M; Matching minimum 30%
- Applications due to NTIA: **September 30, 2022**
- Awards: February 16, 2023
- Start Date: March 1, 2023
- 5-year performance: Buildout 40% Y2, 60% Y3, 80% Y4, 100% Y5
- Applicants: State, Subdivision, Tech Co, Telco, Nonprofit
- Application requirements are complicated and difficult; will limit the applicant pool

- Likely 2024 (after CAB)


Rural Digital Opportunity Fund

• Charter (Spectrum) contractors have been observed doing site assessments only, summer 2022. No physical work started.

ARC - FEDERAL

Appalacian Regional Commission

- 90-100% complete
- Goal reached (56 businesses)
- Missing required service & expenses documentation
- Deadline passed (9/30/2021)
- Skywave won in 2020 (\$387k)

- Provider matches \$600k
- ARP funds remainder
- SCBBC prepares RFP
- State oversees award, implementation
- Timeline begins after GREAT announcements (by year-end)
